College of Home Economics was established in Dhaka in the year of 1961 with an integrated syllabus of Home Economics. Home Management was one of five subjects constructing the integrated syllabus. It continued in the same way until 1985. In this year Home management started its new journey as an independent department with the name "Home Management and Housing". Later on Entrepreneurship related course content was added with considerable importance and Department started another new journey with the name "Resource Management and Entrepreneurship" from 2015.

The vision statement: The philosophy of 'Resource Management and Entrepreneurship' conceives the idea that a collaborative and participatory management style is essential to make our living meaningful and more potential. This style of management study creates awareness among students on issues related to management of resources not only at the household level but also at the community and national levels. It also provides conceptual inputs regarding entrepreneurship management. To make this subject more effective a multidisciplinary course has been chalked out by integrating theories and principles from basic science, arts, social science and business studies.

The mission statement: Major objectives of the course of study are to clarify the meaning of management in present day living, to emphasize resource potential in human beings to achieve personal, household, community and national goals, to familiarize with marketing strategies, family economics, Role of NGOs, women and gender issues and to sensitize and motivate students towards entrepreneurship management and become good entrepreneur.

Available facilities: The Department provides modern systems for lectures and practical works with high quality teaching, learning and research facilities. Teaching in the classroom is facilitated with digital multimedia and other necessary supports. The Department has a rich seminar library with a good collection of reference books. Students are sent to different institutions for an internship course to enhance their quality as a professional. Those who are interested for research work are allowed to pick a thesis course curriculum instead of internship.
